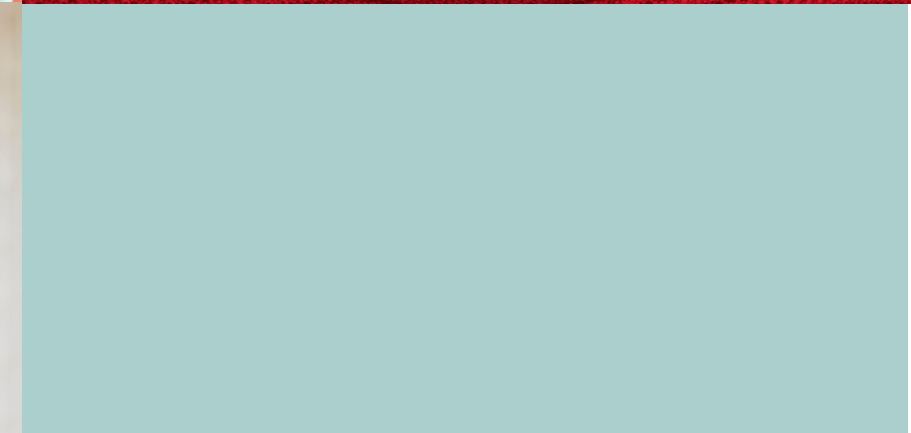

**The Los Angeles Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgement of Institutional Racism (L.A. REPAIR) funds L.A.'s first participatory budget pilot program, where LA Civil Rights, and its Office of Racial Equity, will distribute roughly \$8.5 million to nine LA neighborhoods.**
