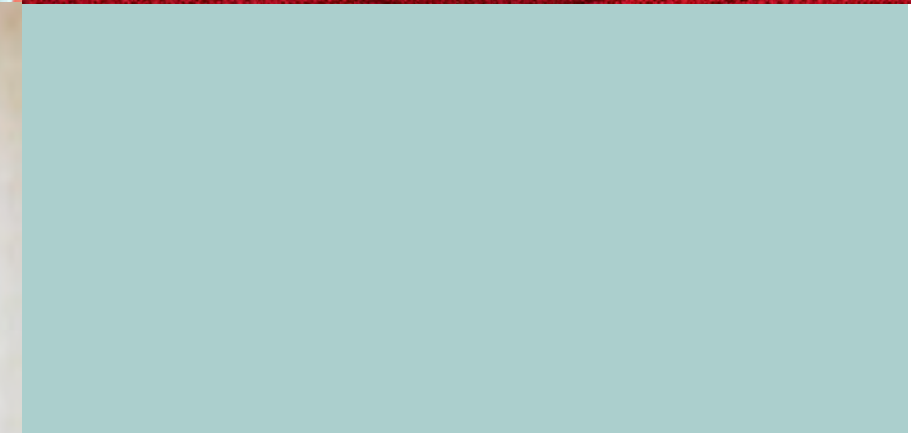

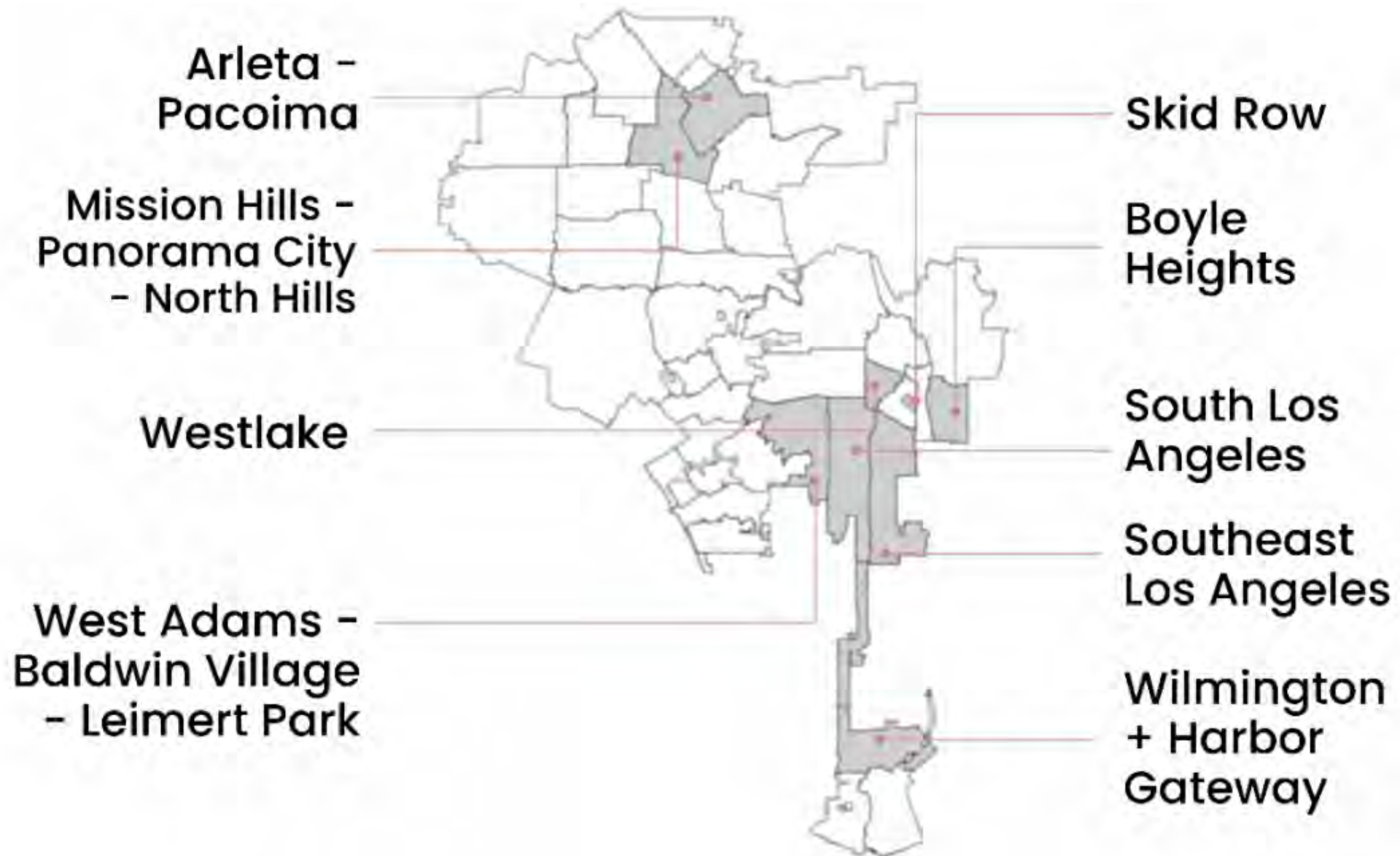

The Los Angeles Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgement of Institutional Racism (L.A. REPAIR) funds L.A.'s first participatory budget pilot program, where LA Civil Rights, and its Office of Racial Equity, will distribute roughly \$8.5 million to nine LA neighborhoods.

The Peace & Healing Centers program, funded through the City of Los Angeles' Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgement of Institutional Racism (REPAIR) Innovation Fund, will partner with local organizations to fund community spaces for environmental, economic, and social healing.
